


Fig. A2. Study plots on the Bird Rock Stack at Cape St. Mary's, Newfoundland and Labrador. Photo credit: Noah G. Careen






Fig. A4. Scatterplot demonstrating the sea surface temperature at which parental Northern Gannets abandoned their nest in 2022.


